

International Stainless Steel & Raw Materials Summit 2018

The 3rd Session International Stainless Steel & Raw Materials Summit 2018 are going to be held by Custeel, Stainless Steel Council of China Special Steel Enterprises Association and Shanghai Futures Exchange at Shangri-La Hotel in Ningbo during May 16-May 18, 2018. The summit is co-organized by Nickel Institute, International Chromium Development Association and International Molybdenum Association (IMOA).

The global economy is expected to be better in 2018. However, the superpower games are intensifying as the regional economy and cooperation are caught in a dilemma. The global stainless steel market continues to diverge: China's stainless steel demand is increasing with the higher supply pressure as its capacity is shifting to Indonesia; while the rapid release of stainless steel capacity in Indonesia has affected the world's supply pattern as well as the market structure in China. As a key raw material of stainless steel smelting, after declines for several years, nickel market rebounded in 2017 again, as the new energy vehicles became the main drive of nickel price. Seeing from a global perspective: What is the future of stainless steel market? Will the demand for nickel of new energy vehicles meet expectations? Will the issue of nickel shortage be eased by increasing ferro-nickel production? How will stainless steel futures market influence development of industrial chains?

Ningbo bounds on the south by the grand canal of China and is one of the starting points of the ancient Maritime Silk Road. Ningbo is also a hub for stainless steel and raw materials trading. The organizers invite stainless steel producers, processing plants, Ni-Cr producers and trading bodies, end-market users, logistics companies, financial & research institutions across the world and so on to discuss the industrial problems and strategies, share market information and extend business opportunities.
